Stars and Nikko

Stars and Nikko have a strong relationship. The story began when priest Shodo, the founder of Nikko, dreamed of a divine revelation from the god of stars when he was seven. The god in his dream told him to build a shrine in Nikko. Then as being told, he enshrined the god of stars nearby Shinkyo bridge. After that, many shrines that enshrines the god of stars have been built not only in Nikko but all over Tochigi prefecture.

Nikko is in the true north of Edo (Tokyo), and the polar star shines right upon the Yomei-mon gate. leyasu Tokugawa wished to be enshrined in Nikko because when people worship the Toshogu shrine, they face the north, which means people, at the same time, worship the polar star that was assumed to be the supreme god in the universe. He regarded himself as the polar star and wishes peace of the world.

The Orion

The locations of shrines and temples in Nikko form the Orion. Although academically not proved, it is said that lemitsu, the third Shogun of Tokugawa, wished for eternity of Tokugawa government upon the stars of the Orion. Nikko has been the ideal place for making wishes, as there exists the Orion on the ground and upon the sky. Let's make wishes under the night sky full of stars in Nikko.

The source area of Watarase river was one of the places where the priest Shodo practiced asceticism. Its rich water wets the Kanto plains. Although Ashio had serious environmental pollution before, now trees are planted on the mountains. Your mind would be purified as you see the clear sky.

🏫 Ryuzoji Temple

It is said that Hideyoshi and Nobunaga sanctified the shrines and temples' area in Nikko and Ahio village. Your dreams would come true, by visiting Ryuzoji temple, a branch temple of Rinnoji temple, and getting holy power of Nikko mountains.

Turukawa Bridge

Furukawa bridge, one of the industrial remains of Ashio copper mine, is the oldest exist iron road bridge in Japan and is registered for the national important cultural properties. You would get the strong mind like iron, standing on the bridge and imagining the old times when Ashio prospered.

Mt. Yokone/ Shounzan Parking

Shounzan parking is located as high as lake Chuzenji, where you can enjoy a panoramic view of the Kanto plains. You can also see many airplanes flying across the starry sky. The Watarase heart-shaped anti-flood pond would win




Tureaino Sato Okorogawa
